

"Gianduja" Torino

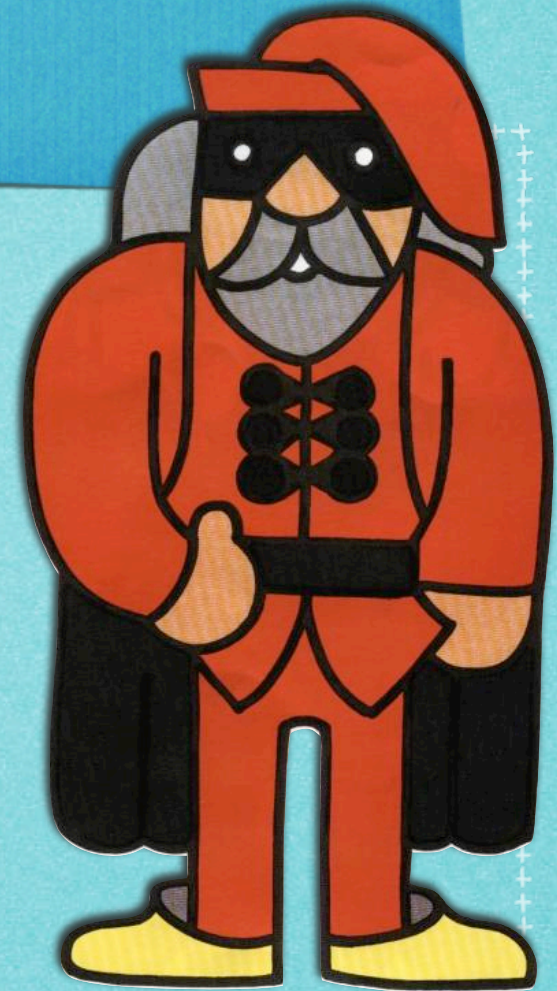
He's a sensible gentleman and he is very brave. He loves good wine and good food.
